An Act to relieve the Electoral Commission and Registration Officers from duty to compile Registers of Voters under the Registration of Voters (National Elections) Act, 1962, and to continue in force certain temporary provisions relating to voters deemed to be registered on the National Register

[5TH JULY, 1963]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Registration of Voters (Temporary Provisions) Act, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Registration of Voters (National Elections) Act, 1962. Short title and construction

2.—(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Registration of Voters (National Elections) Act, 1962, neither the Electoral Commission nor any Registration Officer shall be required to compile or revise any register of voters thereunder, but, until further provision is made for the registration of voters, where, by that Act or any other law an election is directed to be held and persons registered on the national register are entitled to vote at such election, a person whose application for registration under that Act has been accepted and who produces the original copy of his application form signed in the manner prescribed in section 10 thereof, shall continue to be deemed to be registered on the national register in the polling district in which his application was accepted. (2) Notwithstanding section 26 of the Constitution of Tanganyika, C.A. Act 1 until further provision is made for the registration of voters, no person other than a person whose application for registration under the provisions of Part III of the Registration of Voters (National Elections) Act, 1962, has been accepted and who produces the original copy of his application form signed in the manner prescribed in section 10 of that Act, shall be entitled to vote at any election to the National

Assembly, and no person who is not, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of this section, deemed to be registered on the national register shall be entitled to be registered as a voter for the purposes of elections to the National Assembly.
