**An Act to amend the National Service Act, 1964**

[18TH SEPTEMBER, 1964]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanganyika and Zanzibar.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Service (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be read as one with the National Service Act, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act").

Short title and construction Acts 1964 No. 16

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

Section 2 of principal Act amended

(a) in the definition "member", by inserting, immediately after the word and figure "section 5", the words, figure and letter "or appointed to the permanent staff under section 5A"; and

(b) in the definition "Serviceman", by inserting, immediately after the word and figure "section 5", the words, figure and letter "or appointed to the permanent staff under section 5A".

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the word and figure "section 5" in subsection (2), the words, figure and letter "or appointed to the permanent staff under section 5A".

Section 4 of principal Act amended

4. The principal Act is hereby amended by adding immediately below section 5 the following new section:—

New section 5A inserted in principal Act

"Appointments to permanent staff

5A.—(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) or (2) of section 5, appointments may be made to the permanent staff of the National Service on terms other than those prescribed in the said subsections and a citizen appointed to the permanent staff shall, so long as he holds such an appointment, be a Serviceman.

(2) The power to make an appointment of an officer on the permanent staff is vested in the President.

(3) In this section, 'officer' means a person holding a rank declared by rules made under section 21 to be an officer rank."
