An Act to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance

[5TH AUGUST, 1966]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays Ordinance Short title
(Amendment) Act, 1966 and shall be read as one with the Public Cap. 35
Holidays Ordinance.


2. Section 4 of the Public Holidays Ordinance is hereby repealed. Repeal of

Revolution Day (12th January).
The two days upon which the festival of Id-el-Fitr is celebrated.
Good Friday.
Easter Monday.
One day upon which the festival of Id-el-Haj is celebrated.
Union Day (26th April).
International Workers' Day (1st May).
Maulid Day.
Saba Saba Day (7th July).
Independence and Republic Day (9th December).
Christmas Day (25th December).
