T ASSENT

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

An Act to amend

- 1. This Act may be cited as the National Service (Amendment) Act, Short title 1982 and shall be read as one with the National Service Act, 1964.
- 2. The National Service Act, 1964, is amended by adding immediately Cap. 553 below section 5B the following new section:—

"Restriction ment of

5B.—(1) In this section employment on temporary terms on employ- means an employment which does not exceed a period of persons liable Six months.

to serve in the National Service

- (2) No person shall employ or offer employment or issue a licence or permit for carrying out any private business, to any person who is liable to serve in the National Service unless that other person shows evidence that he has already served or that he has been exempted from serving in the National Service.
- (3) A person who is liable to serve in the National Service but has not be called so to serve may be employed but his employment shall be on temporary terms.
- (4) Where, after a period of temporary employment a person who is liable to serve in the National Service, is not called so to serve, he may, with a permit issued in that behalf by the Director, continue being employed on temporary terms.
- (5) Every employer shall notify the Director the name or names of persons who are in his employment and who are liable to serve in the National Service.

(6) Any person who contravenes this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding ten thousand shillings or to imprisonment not exceeding twelve months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
