An Act to validate the proceedings of Conciliation Boards notwithstanding that their Chairmen were appointed otherwise than in accordance with the law

[.....]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

WHEREAS Subsection (1) of Section 10 of the Act provides that the Minister shall, by order published in the *Gazette*, establish throughout Tanganyika such number of Conciliation Boards as he shall consider necessary for the purposes of exercising the functions conferred upon a Board by any law:

AND WHEREAS by Government Notice Number 155 published on 26th March, 1965 the Minister established Boards:

AND WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 11 of the Act it is provided that there shall be a Chairman of each Board who shall be appointed by the Minister:

AND WHEREAS between the 26th day of March, 1965 and the enactment of this Act the Minister had not appointed Chairmen of the Boards in accordance with subsection (1) of Section 11 of the Act:

AND WHEREAS it is now considered desirable to validate any act of the Boards which would have been invalid by reason only that the Minister had not appointed Chairman of the Board in accordance with the law as aforesaid:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Conciliation Boards (Validation of Proceedings) Act, 1983. Short title

Validation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Act” means the Security of Employment Act, 1964.

3. For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that no act, matter or thing done or omitted to be done between the 26th day of March, 1965 and the date of enactment of this Act by any Board in the exercise or purported exercise of any of the powers conferred upon any such Board shall be invalid by reason only that the meeting of the Board was being presided by a Chairman who was appointed otherwise than in accordance with subsection (1) of section 11 of the Act.
